## **Accessibility/ADA Policy**

The Canton Public Library (hereinafter: Library) adheres to the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 that ensures equal access to employment opportunities and access to all Library facilities, services, activities, and programs. Every attempt is made to accommodate the needs of persons with disabilities, and the Library welcomes input from persons with disabilities about ways the Library can more completely serve them.

Questions about ADA compliance, and complaints or suggestions about accessibility of Library facilities or programs should be addressed to the Library Director.

The Library provides forms for contacting the Wolfner Talking Book and Braille Library. Wolfner Library is a free library service for Missourians of all ages who are unable to read standard print materials due to visual impairment, blindness, physical disability, or reading disability, either temporary or permanent. There is no charge to the patron for the following:

- 1. Loan of audio, Braille, and large-print books and magazines;
- 2. Loan of digital audio players;
- 3. Audiobook downloads available 24 hours a day through the website;
- 4. Accessible newspapers and magazines;
- 5. Shipping through the United States Postal Service.
